## 5. Contract description

The EIT intends to conclude contracts for reorganisation of its office space and its supervision by a certified inspector. For this purpose, the EIT is launching a low value negotiated procedure divided into two lots:

Lot 1: Reorganisation of office space. It contains supply of building material and provision of building work based on architecture plans.

Lot 2: Technical supervision of office space reorganisation work indicated in Lot 1

## 6. Indicative budget

The maximum volume of the contract for LOT 1 is EUR 51,000.00 (excluding VAT).

The maximum volume of the contract for LOT 2 is EUR 1,750.00 (excluding VAT).

## 7. Eligibility criteria

Participation in tendering procedures is open on equal terms to all natural and legal persons coming within the scope of the Treaties of the European Union<sup>1</sup>, and to all natural and legal persons in a third country which has a special agreement with the European Union on the conditions laid down in that agreement<sup>2</sup>.

## 8. Submission of expression of interest

All interested economic operators satisfying the eligibility criteria indicated above are invited to submit an expression of interest indicating the tender reference number, their identity (legal entity name) and the contact person; their address and contact details, their areas of specialization and experience.
