DECISION 43/2023 OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN INSTITUTE OF INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY (EIT)

ON ADOPTING THE EIT BUDGET AND ESTABLISHMENT PLAN FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2024

THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN INSTITUTE OF INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 2021/819¹ of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 May 2021 on the European Institute of Innovation and Technology, (hereinafter referred to as the 'EIT Regulation'), and in particular Article 22 thereof and point (1)(b) of Section of the Statutes annexed to the EIT Regulation;

Having regard to Decision 21/2019 of the Governing Board of the EIT of 25 September 2019 on the Financial Regulation of the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (hereinafter referred to as 'EIT Financial Regulation')²;

Having regard to Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 July 2018 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union, amending Regulations (EU) No 1296/2013, (EU) No 1301/2013, (EU) No 1303/2013, (EU) No 1304/2013, (EU) No 1309/2013, (EU) No 1316/2013, (EU) No 223/2014, (EU) No 283/2014, and Decision No 541/2014/EU and repealing Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 (hereinafter referred to as the 'EU Financial Regulation')³;

Having regard to Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/715 of 18 December 2018 on the framework financial regulation for the bodies set up under the TFEU and Euratom Treaty and referred to in Article 70 of Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council (hereinafter referred to as the 'Framework Financial Regulation')⁴, and in particular Article 33 thereof;

WHEREAS

(1) Pursuant to Article 22 (4) of the EIT Regulation, the Governing Board of the EIT shall adopt the EIT's budget. The EIT's budget and establishment plan shall become final following the final adoption of the general budget of the Union. Where appropriate, it shall be adjusted accordingly.

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(2) On 11 November 2023, the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union, on a proposal from the European Commission, have reached an agreement on the EU budget for 2024. The Council approved the joint text on 20 November; and on 22 November 2023, the European Parliament adopted the 2024 EU budget.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The budget of the EIT for the financial year 2024, with the breakdown detailed in the Annex I to this decision, for a total commitment appropriation of EUR 423,898,722.00 and for a total payment appropriation of EUR 423,754,864.00 accompanied by the establishment plan of the EIT for the financial year 2024, as presented in Annex II to this decision, are hereby adopted.

Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on 1 January 2024.

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover remuneration and allowances of temporary staff in accordance with the Staff Regulations of officials and Conditions of employment of other servants of the European Communities. (former expense lines 1100, 1101, 1102)

Expenses and allowances related to entering the service, transfers and termination of service

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the allowance on termination of contract by the EIT for temporary staff members in accordance with the Staff Regulations of officials of the European Communities. (former expense lines 1120,1121)

111 Expenditure related to contract staff

1110 Remuneration and allowances of contract staff

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover remuneration and allowances of contract staff in accordance with the Conditions of employment of other servants of the European Communities. (former expense line 1110)

112 Other staff expenditure

1120 Schooling

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the tuition fee according to EIT decision in force. (former expense line 1130)

1121 Kindergarten

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the early childhood centre fee for dependent children of staff members according to EIT decision in force. (former expense line 1402)

1122 Recruitment

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the expenditure on organising the competitions for interviews and related medical examinations, and the costs of organising procedures for selecting staff. (former expense line 1200)

1123 Mission

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover expenditure on duty travel by staff and SNEs between place of employment and the meeting place. (former expense line 1300)

1124 Medical expense

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the costs of the medical service at the places of work, including the purchase of materials and pharmaceutical products, etc., expenditure on preventive medical check-ups, and expenditure on services provided by outside medical specialists deemed necessary by the medical officers. It also covers expenditure involving the purchase of certain work tools deemed necessary on medical grounds, together with expenditure on medical or paramedical staff under service provision arrangements or on short-term stand-in assignment. (former expense line 1401)

1125 Training

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the introduction courses for new recruits, staff development courses, retraining, courses on the use of modern techniques, seminars, information sessions on EU matters etc. (former expense line 1500)

1126 Social activities

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to encourage and provide financial backing for schemes to promote social contact between staff of different nationalities, for example Christmas lunch, team building, etc. It also covers the financial contribution to participation in social, cultural and sport activities according to the EIT decision in force. (former expense lines 1403,1404)

1127 Representation

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover:

- expenses related to the obligations of the institution regarding external invitations, including in connection with work carried out by the EIT's units, and representation expenses for the Director and Head of Units,
- the Secretariat's reception and representation expenses, including the purchase of tokens,
- miscellaneous protocol expenditure, such as on flags, display stands, invitation cards, printed menus, etc. (former expense line 1700)

120 External personnel

1200 Agency staff

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the employment of interim staff. (former expense line 1600)

1201 Seconded National Expert

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the cost of national officials or other experts on secondment or temporary assignments to the EIT or called for short consultations from within and outside the European Union. (former expense line 1601)

1202 Trainee

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover expenditure incurred in particular administrative training for young students. This expenditure includes trainee's social security allowances and contributions, travel expenses at the beginning and end of the course, as well as travel expenses for travel connected with the training programme. (former expense line 1602)

1203 Administrative assistance in support of different activities

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover expenditure incurred by the Commission for administrative assistance given to the EIT, like computerised payroll service, mission calculation, translation, etc., plus any other expenditure on technical and administrative assistance outsourced by the EIT under ad hoc service contracts such as certification of the accounts. (former expense lines 1603,1604,1610,1611)

210 Building expense

2100 Building rental, acquisition

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the payment of rents or the expenditure of acquistion of occupied buildings or part of buildings and the renting of storerooms, garages, off-site storage, meeting rooms, parking facilities and flag poles, etc. (former expense lines 2000,2001)

2101 Building maintenance and security

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the costs of maintenance, security and utilities in the buildings, meeting rooms, warehouses, garages, car parks etc. used by the EIT, including:

- consumption of water, gas, electricity, heating, etc.;
- maintenance of central heating and air conditioning systems;
- periodic cleaning, purchase of supplies for maintenance;
- costs of repainting, repairs and supplies needed in maintenance workshops;
- expenditure relating to selective waste treatment, storage and disposal;
- expenditure relating to physical and material security of property, more specific buildings surveillance contracts;
- maintenance of security installations and purchase of small-scale equipment;
- expenditure relating to health and protection of persons at the workplace, and in particular the maintenance of fire-fighting equipment, updating teams of officials serving as fire pickets, statutory inspections;
- refitting work such as moving partitions, changes to technical installations and other specific jobs relating to doors and locks, electricity, sanitary fittings, painting, floor coverings etc., and modifications to network gear incorporated in the building;
- purchases and cleaning of protective clothing for workshop staff and other maintenance staff requiring protection against bad weather and cold, abnormal wear & tear and dirt as necessary;
- legal, financial and technical advice prior to acquiring, renting or construction of buildings;
- management of buildings, establishment of inventories,
- etc. (former expense lines 2002,2003,2004,2005,2006)

2109 Other building expense

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover expenditure as regards buildings not specifically provided for in the other budget lines, for example levz on immovable property, local taxes, etc. (former expense line 2009)

211 Equipment expense

2110 Furniture rental, acquisition and associated cost

Remark

This appropriation is intended to cover the purchase and/or hire of office furniture and specialised furniture, including ergonomic furniture, shelving for archives, etc. as well as their maintenance, repair cost. (former expense lines 2220, 2221)

2111 Technical equipment rental, acquisition and associated cost

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the purchase/rental and initial installation, or renewal of equipment used for reproduction and archiving of documentation in any form, as well as large kitchen equipment and other mail handling, library, interpreting, and other technical and office equipment as well as its maintenance and repair cost. (former expense lines 2200, 2201)

220 ICT equipment and services

2200 IT software and hardware expenditure

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover expenditure of purchasing, rental of IT equipment (e.g. Computers, tablets, connection equipment, etc.) and software necessary for their operation. It also covers the installation, the configuration and consultancy fee related to the equipment and software. It also covers the cost of EC tools (HAN, ABAC, Sysper, Bluebell, Speedwell, etc.). (former expense lines 2100,2101)

2201 Communication equipment and services

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the cost of communications (landline, mobile, internet, audio- and videoconferencing, including data transmission) services as purchase/rental of communication equipment and their maintenance. (former expense line 2302)

230 Miscellaneous expenditure

2300 Office supplies

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the purchase of office supplies, including:

- purchase of paper, envelopes, office supplies, products for the reproduction workshop and certain printing and reproduction work contracted out;
- installation, configuration, maintenance (limited to hardware!), supplies for office IT equipment (computers, printers, fax machines, photocopiers, scanners, cameras etc.) worth < EUR420;
- purchase of special fittings for kitchens;
- office furniture supplies worth < €420;
- expenditure for medical supplies (medicine, bandage, etc.); etc. (former expense lines 1400, 2300)

2301 Postage and delivery charges

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover expenditure on postal and delivery charges, including parcels sent by post. (former expense line 2301)

2302 Transport cost

Remarks

This action is intended to cover taxi expenditure, acquiring public transportation tickets for staff in accordance with the relevant EIT decision in force. (former expense line 2210,2211,2212)

2303 Legal expense

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover legal expenses, including

- $expenditure \ on \ pre-litigation \ proceedings \ and \ assistance \ from \ lawyers \ or \ other \ experts \ advising \ the \ EIT;$
- expenditure to be borne by the EIT by way of damages and expenditure occasioned by its civil liability and cases involving the staff and administration:

2306 Expenditure related to EIT Governing Board

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover honoraria, travel expense and other cost of the members of the Governing Board and of the Executive Committee as well as the organisational cost of overning Board and Executive Committee meetings and other expenditure related to meetings, events, seminars where the member of the Governing Board and Executive Committee represents the EIT. (E.g. representation cost, meal, conference fee, etc.) (former expense lines 2306,2500)

2307 Studies and surveys

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover expenditure for specialised studies contracted to experts or consultants when the EIT with its staff, does not have the relevant expertise in the field of administration. It also covers the cost of staff surveys. (former expense line 2403)

2308 Meeting expense

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover costs connected with the organization of internal meetings, cost of beverages, refreshments and occasional light meals served at meetings held by the EIT. (former expense lines 2510,2520,2521)

2309 Other administrative expense

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover other administrative expenditures that can not be charged to the budget lines, e.g. registration fees for conferences other than training, membership fees of professional and scientific associations. (former expense lines 2305,2309)

3204 EIT Awards

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the cost of implementing the EIT Awards which reward successful EIT innovations, entrepreneurial start-ups and graduates from EIT labelled education programmes, to showcase EIT success stories and to enhance awareness about the EIT. (former expense line 3205)

3205 International cooperation

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the expenses related to strengthening the standing of the EIT among the global innovation community through a structured dialogue with third countries and international organisations.

3206 Monitoring and evaluation of impact

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the expense related to the monitoring of KICs operations and portfolio to strengthen the EIT's grant control, to obtain basis for performance based funding, as well as to get insights into results of KICs activities. It also covers the cost of evaluation and miximising future KICs impact. (former expense line 3303)

3207 Identification and sharing of good practices

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the cost of dissemination of results and good practices from the EIT Community. (former expense line 3113)

Remarks

This appropriation is intended to cover the cost of implementing the new action to support entrepreneurship and innovation in higher education.
