3	Purposes of the processing	<p>The processing of the personal data within the context of the INNOVEIT Brussels: EIT Summit 2022 is necessary for the following purposes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- To register people participating in the event;</li> <li>- To ensure the efficient organisation and management of the event, including the management of participation list, invitations, reporting and follow-up activities;</li> <li>- To create awareness and promote the visibility of the event, particularly by means of media and publications.</li> </ul> <p>INNOVEIT Brussels: EIT Summit is part of INNOVEIT WEEKS 2022, a <a href="#">series of thematic events</a> taking place between September and October 2022, nine of them organised by the Knowledge and Innovation Communities (KICs) and one by the EIT. The present privacy statement covers the processing of personal data for the event organised and hosted by the EIT (see below); information about the events organised and hosted by the KICs can be requested from them.</p> <p>The INNOVEIT Brussels: the EIT Summit will be held in a <b>hybrid format</b> on 11 October 2022:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- at the EGG, Rue Bara 175, 1070 in Brussels, Belgium;</li> <li>- online via the YouTube platform.</li> </ul>

		<p>Registration is required only for in person participants of the event, whose registration is managed via an online registration page, maintained by ICF NEXT S.A., the contractor of the EIT (see below).</p> <p>The online web streaming of the INNOVEIT Brussels: EIT Summit can be watched on YouTube without a registration, on the <a href="#">EIT's Youtube Channel</a>, therefore the EIT does not process the personal data of participants joining online. During the event only the stage/podium area will be shown via the web streaming, therefore the other participants who do not appear in this area of the venue of the physical event will not be subject to web streaming. For the purpose of asking questions while watching the event via YouTube, you may be required to log in through your Google account, Facebook account, etc. Be aware that EIT is not responsible for processing personal data by YouTube or any other company, which applications you use to attend the event online. You may consult the privacy statements of these companies for more information.</p>
4	<b>Categories of data subjects</b>	The data subjects are the registered event participants.
5	<b>Categories of the personal data processed</b>	<p>Within the context of the INNOVEIT Brussels: EIT Summit organised by the EIT, the following types of personal data are processed in relation to the data subjects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- As part of the online registration process the following personal data are processed for <u>all participants</u>: title, family name, first name, nationality, name and type of the organisation, position in the organisation, membership status of the EIT Alumni, contact details: e-mail address, telephone number (optional), the role in the event. In addition to the above, participants at the event may be given the opportunity to indicate individual requirements e.g. those pertaining to diet, mobility and attendance at the event.</li> <li>- For <u>Speakers, EIT Awards Nominees and EIT Awards Jury members</u>, the following additional data are processed in the context of the event: phone number, details of the travel document (ID/passport) including full name, date of birth, ID/passport number, ID/passport expiration date, issuing country and date of the issue for the purpose of the travel assistance by the EIT.</li> <li>- <u>For the other participants covered by the EIT</u> (e.g. EIT Governing Board members, members of the Members States Representatives Group, moderator): the details of the travel document (ID/passport) including full name, date of birth, ID/passport number, ID/passport expiration date, issuing country and date of the issue are collected and processed for the purpose of the travel assistance by the EIT.</li> <li>- The contact details of the participants may be included in the <u>EIT Stakeholder Database</u>: if the data subject wishes that his/her contact details appear in the database, he/she should tick the appropriate box during the online registration;</li> </ul>

		<p>- <u>Photographs/pictures</u> will be taken during the event and video shots will be recorded. <u>Audio and video recording</u> of the <i>stage/podium area</i> will be taken and disseminated by means of live web streaming. For all the above processing operations, the data subject can decide to explicitly give his/her permission during the online registration. In case the data subject does not give consent, he/she will be given a badge with a special sign on it and will be provided with the special area where no pictures/videos are taken. The photographs/pictures, presentations, audio and video recording and live streaming of the event will be reproduced in various media including EIT publications, the EIT website, social media networks, TV channels and the press, in connection with the event for visibility purposes and/or for further institutional purposes as well as for promotional activities of the EIT.</p>
6	Categories of data recipients	<p><b>Within the EIT:</b></p> <p>For the purposes indicated above, access to personal data is provided to the EIT staff responsible for the organisation of the event and for the follow-up activities (e.g. satisfaction survey for participants).</p> <p><b>Within the Commission and other EU institutions/bodies/agencies:</b></p> <p>Access may also be provided for the fulfillment of their tasks to the Internal Audit Service of the Commission, the Court of Auditors (audit purposes), to the European Ombudsman, the European Data Protection Supervisor or the European Court of Justice and the General Court (in case of complaints or litigation).</p> <p><b>Third parties subject to the GDPR<sup>2</sup> and third parties not subject to the GDPR:</b></p> <p>ICF NEXT S.A., as the external contractor of the EIT involved in the organisation of the event, is processing the personal data on behalf of the EIT. The written framework contract between the EIT and ICF Next S.A. contains several provisions on the protection of personal data. 		<p>In particular, as event organiser, ICF is responsible for maintaining the online registration process, management of audio and video recordings, web streaming, taking photographs and recording video footage about the event, follow-up reporting, distribution of follow up satisfaction surveys etc. The personal data indicated above are collected, uploaded and stored on its servers based in Europe, consulted, transmitted to the EIT, used and finally erased at the end of the retention period.</p> <p>ICF uses B2MATCH Platform for the purpose of registration to the conference. When the data subjects register to the conference, they are made aware that B2MATCH collects the personal data included in the registration form. In addition, B2MATCH collects the data subjects' IP addresses, website data, geolocation, and browser-generated information (including device information, operating system, device type, system, cookies or other technologies used to analyse users' activity). For details about B2MATCH privacy practices please read: <a href="https://www.b2match.com/privacy-policy">https://www.b2match.com/privacy-policy</a>.</p> <p>In addition, two travel agencies, Gray Dawes, United Kingdom (privacy policy: <a href="https://www.gdg.travel/wp-content/uploads/2022/04/GRAY-DAWES-TRAVEL-GDPR-Policy-2022b.pdf">https://www.gdg.travel/wp-content/uploads/2022/04/GRAY-DAWES-TRAVEL-GDPR-Policy-2022b.pdf</a>), and IP Travel, Belgium will process the data subjects' personal details in order to organise and manage travel for sponsored participants. ICF will share the data subjects' personal data with the travel agency for travel organisation purposes in accordance with this privacy statement, based on an adequacy decision of the Commission regarding the United Kingdom.</p> <p>Finally, ICF shares the personal data of the participants covered by the EIT with certain hotels in Brussels (such as Hotel Pullman Brussels Centre Midi (Place Victor Horta 1, 1060 Brussels) and Hotel Manos Premier (Chaussée de Charleroi 100/106, 1060, Brussels)), which will process the data subjects' personal details to organise and manage accommodation for sponsored participants. ICF will share your personal data with the hotels for accommodation management purposes in accordance with this privacy statement.</p>
7	<b>Time limit storage</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- For <u>the rejected applications to participate in the event</u>, the retention period is <i>15 days</i> after the day of the event;</li> </ul>

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- For the <u>contact details of the participants who gave their consent to be included in the EIT Stakeholder Database</u> the retention period is <i>4 years</i> (see the separate privacy statement on the EIT website<sup>3</sup>);</li> <li>- For the <u>contact details of the participants who did not want to be included in the EIT Stakeholder Database</u> the retention period is <i>2 years</i>;</li> <li>- Reports of the event will be kept for audit purposes for a period of <i>5 years</i> after the INNOVEIT 2022 budget is discharged in accordance with the EU Financial Regulation<sup>4</sup> and the EIT Financial Regulation;</li> <li>- After the above-mentioned retention periods the data relating to the event required for scientific or historical research purposes, statistical purposes should be kept in an anonymous form.</li> </ul>
